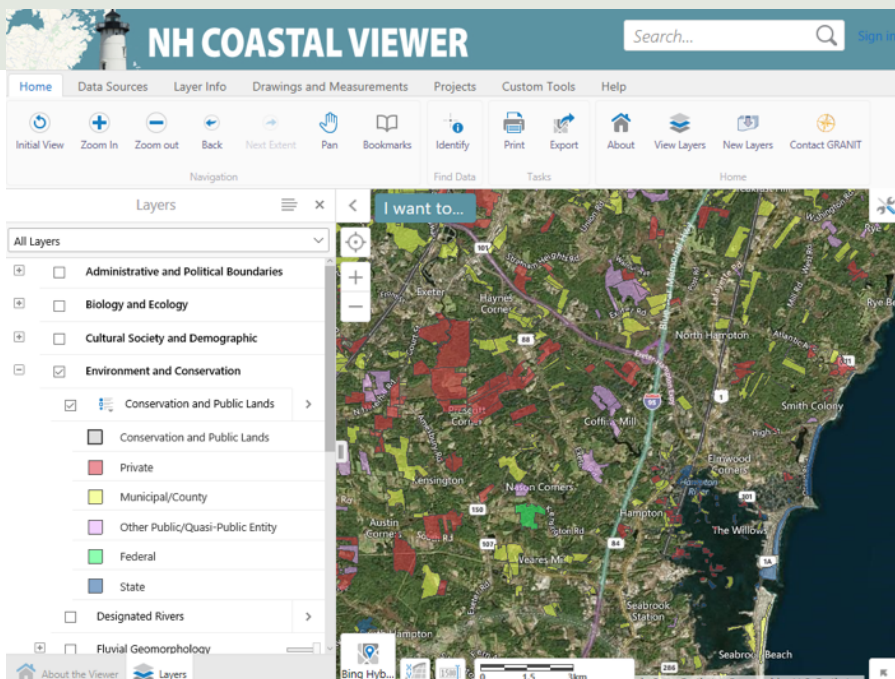


Coastal Viewer 101 For Land Conservation

The workshop will include a brief presentation on the Viewer, followed by a series of hands-on exercises to familiarize participants with the Viewer's data and tools.
