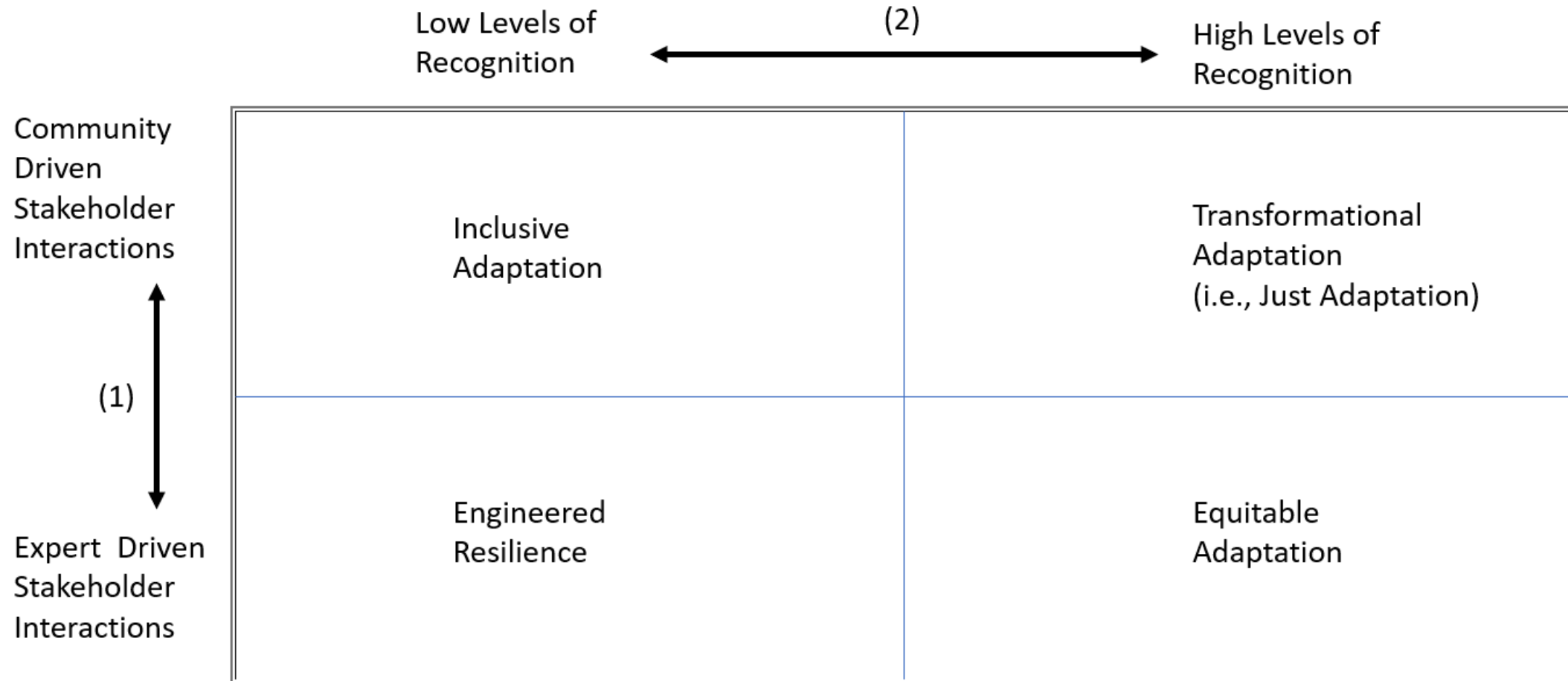
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Key Takeaway: collaborating with the transportation sector is essential to promote equitable transformation
