






Key Takeaway: collaborating with the transportation sector is essential to promote equitable transformation

Dimensions of Justice in climate adaptation policy implementation



- (1) Varying degrees of interaction among stakeholders
- (2) Degree of power and agency in decision-making processes





- Build collaborative partnerships with the transportation sector <u>Infrastructure</u> <u>Mobility & Equity</u>
- Focus on incremental evaluations of adaptation practice
- Align climate resilient policy implementation with the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law (BIL) and other applicable grant programs to achieve broad societal benefit (PROTECT, RAISE, Reconnecting Communities Pilot)
